
PERFORMANCE AND ECONOMY

Aspire does, of course, provide the benefits that *are* expected in a car its size. Economy, for one (EPA estimates are 36 city/42 hwy manual; 29 city/34 hwy automatic). Yet the 1.3L I-4 engine also offers a good measure of power. This blend of performance and economy makes Aspire well suited for both stop-and-go city traffic and highway cruising.


Designing a subcompact car is a very demanding proposition. The shape must certainly

GREAT PASSENGER/ CARGO VERSATILITY


In addition to its uncommon comfort, Aspire also offers a lot of versatility for both passengers and cargo. In the 3-door model, the rear seat backs can be folded forward to form a cargo area. If more space is needed, the entire rear seat assembly can be folded up against the front seat backs to form a flat load floor and take advantage of the maximum storage capacity.


With the split/fold rear seat, available with both 3-door and 5-door, (part of the optional Interior Decor and Convenience Group with Aspire; standard in Aspire SE) there's even more flexibility. One seat back can be folded forward to accommodate a passenger along with long cargo (skis for example), or both can come forward when cargo takes precedence.

INTERIOR ENHANCEMENT

ASPIRE CAPABILITY

Although Aspire's smooth styling is indeed eye-catching, it's what's under the skin that provides the real driving satisfaction. A lot of capability is built in. Engineered to be a satisfying blend of performance characteristics, Aspire is equally at home in stop-and-go city traffic or out on the open road.

ASPIRE'S POWERTRAIN

The 1.3 liter I-4 engine provides plenty of power, yet is designed to achieve impressive fuel economy (EPA estimates are 36 city/42 hwy manual; 29 city/34 hwy auto). Multiple-port electronic fuel injection ensures improved operation, smooth running and easy starting, even in temperature extremes.

The standard manual transaxle has a fifth overdrive gear to reduce engine wear and help stretch the mpg. Likewise, the optional 3-speed automatic has a lock-up feature for greater operating efficiency.

GOOD ROAD MANNERS

Aspire features an optional computer-controlled anti-lock braking system which provides added control in many hard braking situations (see page 10). The standard braking system is comprised of hard-working discs up front and self-adjusting drums in the rear for surefooted stops.

ASPIRE SAFETY & ENGINEERING

When it comes to the automobile, there's certainly no issue more important than occupant safety. The well-being of passengers is the concern of every driver. That's why safety has always been such a high priority at Ford Motor Company.

A HISTORY OF LEADERSHIP

As early as 1956, Ford cars had standard features such as


In the '80s, we were the first U.S. manufacturer to offer electronic 4-wheel anti-lock brakes in passenger cars.

STANDARD DUAL AIR BAGS

Aspire is an excellent example of Ford's leadership in the area of safety. It was the first car in its class to offer standard driver and front passenger air bags. Together with properly worn lap/shoulder safety belts, the air bags help protect the vehicle's occupants in certain moderate to severe frontal impacts and are one of the most effective passenger restraint systems available in automobiles today.

OPTIONAL ANTI-LOCK BRAKE SYSTEM

Aspire was the first car in its class to offer an optional 4-wheel anti-lock system to augment the power front disc/rear drum brakes. This system helps prevent wheel lockup due to hard braking. With anti-lock, each wheel is monitored during braking. If impending lockup is detected, brake pressure is automatically modulated many times per second. The brakes are applied and then released repeatedly in the same way you were probably taught

But the speed of the anti-lock braking system far exceeds human capability, providing the driver a much greater degree of steering control during hard braking situations on a variety of slippery road surfaces.

FRONT-WHEEL-DRIVE TRACTION

Aspire's front-wheel-drive configuration puts the weight of the engine and transaxle over the driving wheels. This arrangement can help improve traction under adverse conditions such as snowy roads.

CHILDPROOF LOCKS

To all parents, the safety of their children is paramount. Aspire's "childproof" rear door locks on 5-door models help keep curious little fingers out of mischief. When activated, the rear doors can't be opened from inside. It's one less worry while you're trying to concentrate on driving.

DUAL OUTSIDE MIRRORS

When it comes to the road, the more you can see, the better prepared you're going to be for any eventuality. That goes for what's behind you as well as what's ahead. As a measure to help increase driver visibility, all Aspire models provide dual outside rearview mirrors as standard equipment.
