The Ford 5.0L HO engine, with its multi-port sequential electronic fuel injection system, is among the most powerful production engines available in America, and it's the standard engine in the Mustang GT and LX 5.0L performance models.

These road specialists combine a wide, aggressive stance with 16-inch cast aluminum wheels, P225/55ZR performance tires and a deliberate performance suspension system which includes Ford's quadrashock configuration in the rear and a progressive-rate spring at each corner.

With this kind of handling hardware, you'd naturally expect to find an interior equipped with comfortable.



The 5.0L High-Output V-8 engine generates 225 horsepower (SAE rating) and 300 lb. ft. of torque, reassuring indeed for situations like passing when extra power translates into extra confidence.
