


The Honda Civic was engineered from scratch for today's kind of driving. It's remarkable. Start with the Honda 1237cc single overhead cam engine. It doesn't need a catalytic converter, and it runs on regular, low-lead or no-lead gas.

Notice the Honda Civic design. The engine is mounted sideways, so there's more room on the inside and with front-wheel drive there's no transmission hump. Inside, the Honda Civic holds four adults and luggage, too. In the Hatchback model, the rear seat folds down for even more carrying space.

Plus there's the standard engineering features on a Civic—features that many cars don't have: Rack and pinion steering, front-wheel drive, four wheel independent MacPherson Strut suspension, and a power-assisted dual-diagonal braking system with front disc brakes. Then there's the locking fuel filler door, front mud guards, full interior carpeting, hinged rear side windows, tinted glass, adjustable reclining front bucket seats, and simulated wood dash trim. Plus whitewall tires and an AM radio on the Hatchback. Nice things to have on a car. Standard on the Honda Civic.




