These advances also enable Hyundai vehicles to automatically engage braking and steering as a means of helping drivers avoid collisions.⁴

Hyundai SmartSense, our array of advanced technologies designed to help protect you from every angle, includes features like a Surround View Monitor and Rear Cross-Traffic Collision Warning to help you safely back out of parking spaces. As you drive down the road, Forward Collision-Avoidance Assist, Blind-Spot Collision Warning and Lane Keeping Assist help you maneuver through traffic with confidence. At the end of your journey, an award-winning innovation called Safe Exit Assist helps prevent passengers from opening a door into other vehicles approaching alongside your parked Hyundai.

Forward Collision-Avoidance Assist with Pedestrian Detection
If a pedestrian or slowing/stopped vehicle is detected in your path, emergency braking is automatically applied to help avoid or reduce the severity of a collision.⁶



Blind-Spot Collision-Avoidance Assist
Like having extra eyes at your side, this feature warns you if there's a vehicle in your blind spot before you change lanes and applies braking on the opposite side of the attempted lane change if necessary to help avoid a collision.⁷



Rear Cross-Traffic Collision-Avoidance Assist
This feature warns of vehicles approaching from the side when you're backing out of parking spaces in reverse gear and applies braking automatically to help avoid a collision.⁸



Lane Keeping Assist
Audio and visual cues warn you if your vehicle drifts out of its driving lane without signaling. If necessary, the system gently applies corrective steering assistance to help keep you inside the lane.⁹



Safe Exit Assist
When your vehicle is parallel parked on a busy street, this pioneering innovation alerts occupants planning to exit of vehicles approaching from behind. When Child Locks are active, Safe Exit Assist prevents the rear doors from opening if a vehicle approaching from behind is detected.¹⁰



Low/High Beam Assist
Low Beam Assist illuminates cornering headlight beams in sync with your steering to help improve your vision around corners. High Beam Assist switches high beams off/on automatically to help avoid distracting oncoming drivers.



Smart Cruise Control with Stop & Go
When a vehicle in front of you is detected to be slowing, Smart Cruise Control automatically reduces your speed. It can even slow your vehicle to a complete stop and restart automatically when equipped with Stop & Go functionality.¹¹

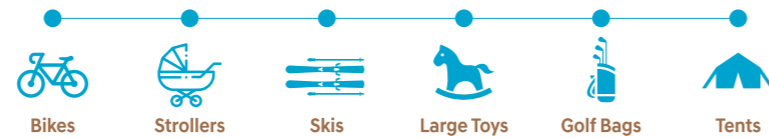

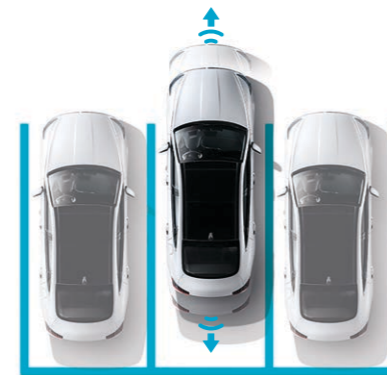

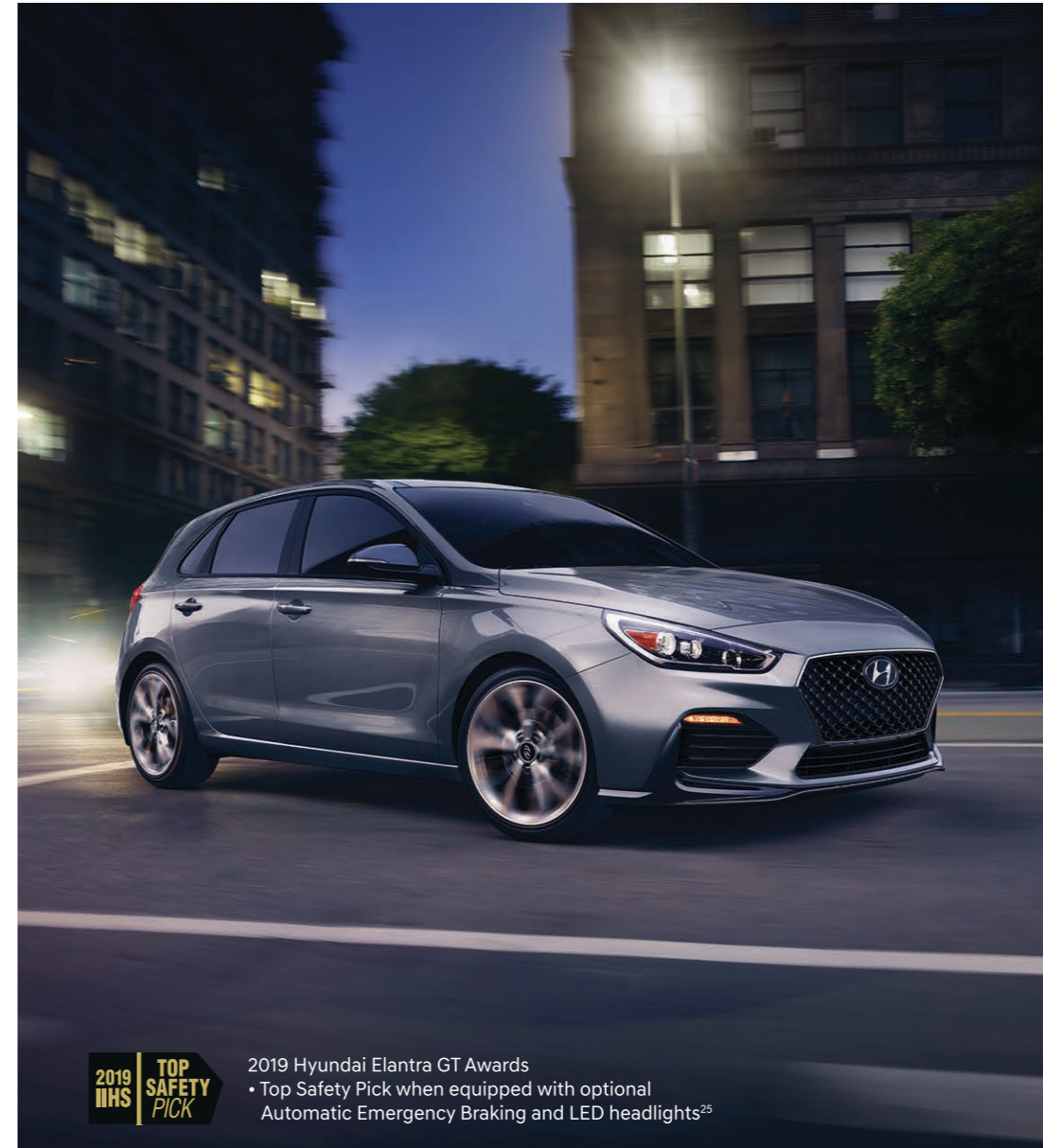

Even when it's driverless, NEXO delights with next-generation technologies like Remote Smart Parking Assist, which can search for – and drive into or out of – parking spaces remotely.²⁶

NEXO utilizes the remote capabilities of another Hyundai innovation: Blue Link®. Using our Blue Link app on your smartphone or smartwatch, or your Amazon Echo® or Google Home device,²⁴ you can remotely lock or unlock your NEXO's doors, start the engine and activate the climate controls from the comfort of your kitchen, couch or office.

Behind the rear seats, you'll have plenty of space to load up to your liking thanks to a cargo volume that almost doubles the Toyota Mirai.²³ A modern, airy cabin with generous front and rear legroom also includes innovations like a Blind-Spot View Monitor³⁰ and large 12.3" navigation touchscreen display. There's also a wireless charging pad – like NEXO itself, it'll quickly recharge your compatible devices to keep you on the move.¹⁸

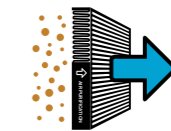
