



**The Porsche Carrera.  
Inspiration for a New Porsche Generation.**





This year we've added something new to our Porsches. A 2.7 liter engine. It's basically the same one used in the racing Carrera. But we've tamed it to perform superbly on the street.

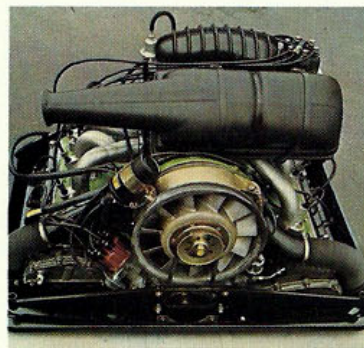
The new engine is larger, with more torque at low rpm's. So you can do more driving and less shifting.

There's one overhead camshaft for each bank of cylinders, and sodium-cooled exhaust valves. And even though the engine is larger than before, that doesn't mean it's heavier. We made it light for a favorable ratio between engine weight and power.

Something else that's new this year is CIS fuel injection. It's a new system that works by measuring the intake air flow of the engine and uses this measurement to control the flow of fuel and air to the cylinders.

Even though each of the Porsche models (911, 911 S and Carrera) share these features, each one has some special features that give it a personality all its own. Your Porsche Audi dealer will be glad to explain these differences so you can choose the model that's right for you.







With all the Porsche racing victories, it's easy to forget that most Porsches are driven in normal everyday traffic. That's why we designed the Porsche to offer the interior comfort of an expensive sedan.

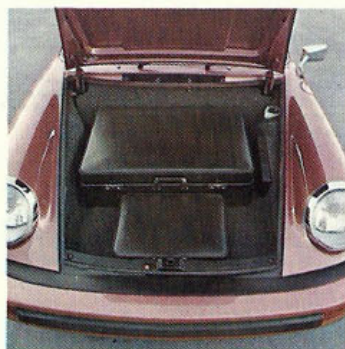

Deep bucket seats provide comfort and stability in all driving situations. And the seat belts with inertia reels allow the driver and passenger unhindered free-

dom of movement, yet lock-up tight for protection when needed.

The carpeted front luggage compartment offers about 7 cubic feet of storage. And behind the seats is a second area with another 8.3 cubic feet of space for luggage.
