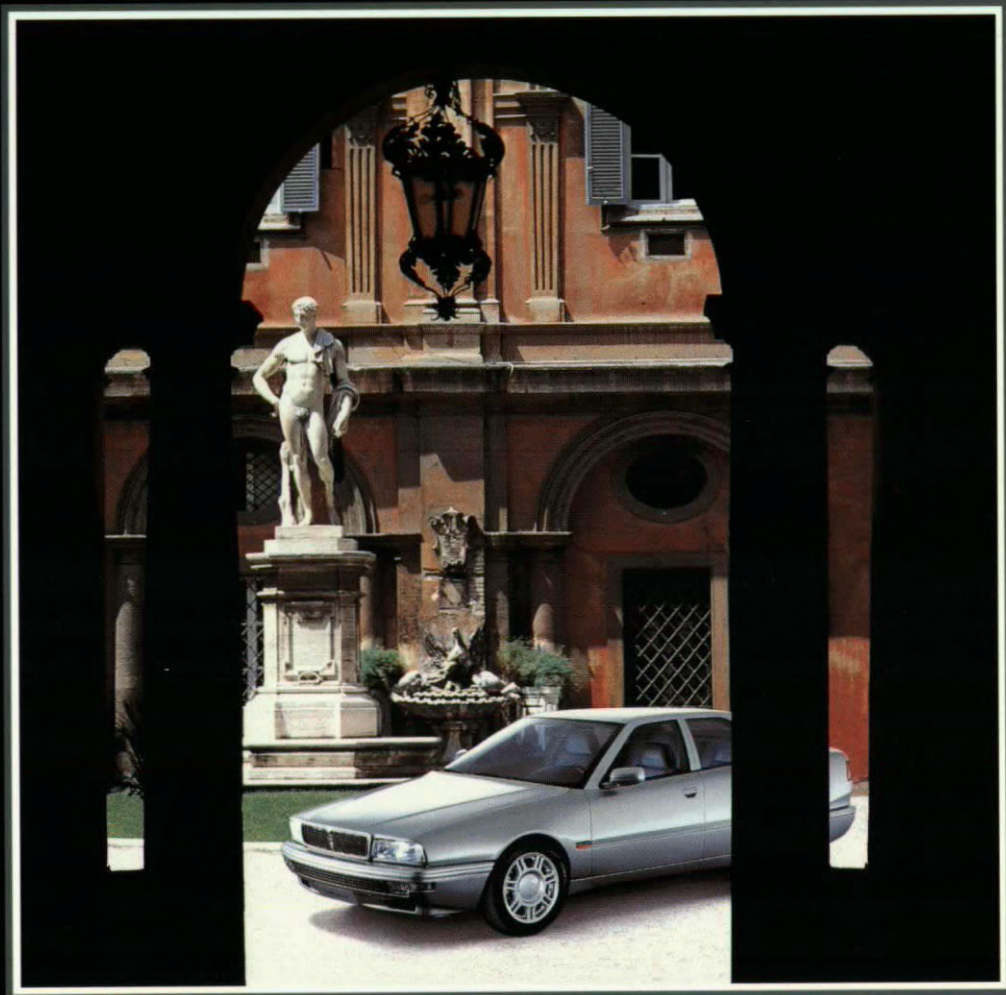
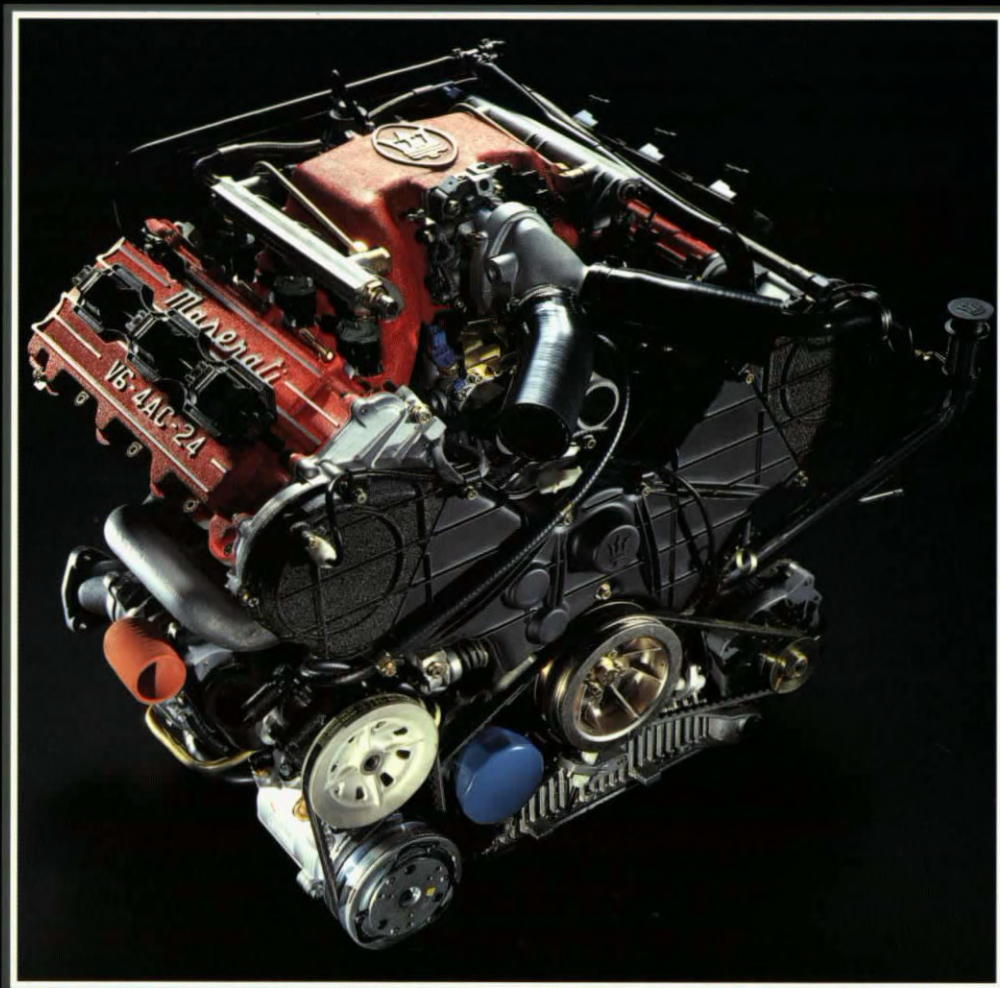

**COMFORT.** The Maserati **Quattroporte** has been thought out, designed and built for an élite clientele with a preference for the convenience of a roomy, easy of access and comfortable four-door saloon. For people who appreciate an exclusive car not just on account of the prestige conferred by its marque, with all that this brings with it in terms of performance, but also because of its extraordinary driving and travelling comfort, and a peerless occupancy quality.

An appreciation that stems from a surprisingly rich array of

fitments: dash in leather and burr elm; seats in Connolly leather; automatic ventilation and air conditioning system; steering wheel adjustable for height and fore and aft; electrically adjustable wing mirrors; central door locking; 3-point safety belts with pretensioner, adjustable for height, rear 3-point safety belts with automatic rewind plus central lap belt; power seats, adjustable for height, and fore and aft, with manual lumbar setting; front head-rests, manually adjustable for height and rake; rear sunshades; Alpine car radio with specific diffusion plant.

Maserati **Quattroporte**: a legend gains another chapter written with a craftsman's hand and the finer pen provided by today's most advanced and sophisticated technologies.

**Quattroporte**, in fact, is not a new term in the Maserati lexicon. It was used back in November 1963, when the Trident marque entered the world of the top-flight saloons. A car that wedded luxury, roominess and comfort to the performance and élan drivers had come to associate with the name Maserati.

The newcomer, too, is a happy marriage of performance and elegance, power and class, sportiness and comfort. And with something extra in the form of a design philosophy aimed at adding occupancy quality as another string to Maserati's bow by offering the very best in roominess, pleasing surroundings and a wealth of fitments. Everything about the new **Quattroporte** combines to create an ambiance whose hallmark is elegance and ease of enjoyment: from the dash lined in leather, and enriched with burr elm inserts, to the luxurious Connolly leather seats.

Maserati **Quattroporte**: a philosophy whose on-the-road tenets are pleasurable driving, a comfortable ride and a quality of occupancy that place this car among the chosen few at the very top of the tree.

**THE SHAPE.** Aerodynamic, aggressive, but at the same time sober, refined and noble. Not for nothing was the **Quattroporte** designed in collaboration with Marcello Gandini, one of Italy's most quoted stylists in the top-performance automobile sector.

The wide sloping front with its powerful hold-down effect is a clear hint of the superb performance in store.

The generous glazing, too, is a foretaste of pleasant journeys and safe driving.

The sides underscore the vehicle's distinctly sporty personality, while its wedge-like profile is further enhanced by the upward slant of the rear wheel arch, a typical stroke of Gandini's pencil and one that proves that a substantial volume is no bar to a dashing line.





Sleek overall dimensions are the source of its superb handling qualities on twisting roads, while a long wheelbase ensures a steady course at high speed.

Maserati **Quattroporte**: a new way of looking at the classic and the sporty combined at the top of the saloon range in a bold signature whose style hits the mark with a flourish, unmistakably Maserati.

**THE ENGINE.** 2790 cc, V-6 delivering 284 hp at 6000 rpm, with maximum 42,1 kgm torque at 3500 rpm, 4 valves per cylinder, 2 overhead camshafts for each row of cylinders, 2 liquid-cooled turbochargers, 2 air-to-air intercoolers, dual catalytic converter, light-alloy crankcase and cylinder heads, electronic injection and ignition.

**THE ENGINEERING.** A mighty power plant is obviously a must for a vehicle with its eyes on the sports car label. Excellent roadholding, however, is the other half of the story. And for this you need a firm body shell, and

suspensions fully alive to the demands imposed by an impetuous performance spectrum.

One of the outstanding prerogatives of the **Quattroporte**, in fact, is its extraordinarily rigid floor pan. A feature of the construction that maximises safety and makes driving a sheer pleasure: torsion is a word without meaning, and a spot-on line when cornering is assured, while the suspensions guarantee excellent roadholding around bends. And on the subject of suspensions: those fitted on the **Quattroporte** ensure perfect stability under the most exacting conditions.

**SAFETY.** 3-channel, 4-sensor ABS, airbag, front seat belts with pre-tensioner; side impact cross bars on all four doors; progressive energy-absorbing front and rear boxes; high-rigidity body shell and floor pan, shielded fuel tank, inertia fuel cut-off, excellent night and high-speed visibility; outside thermometer with warning LED indicating the risk of ice on the road.

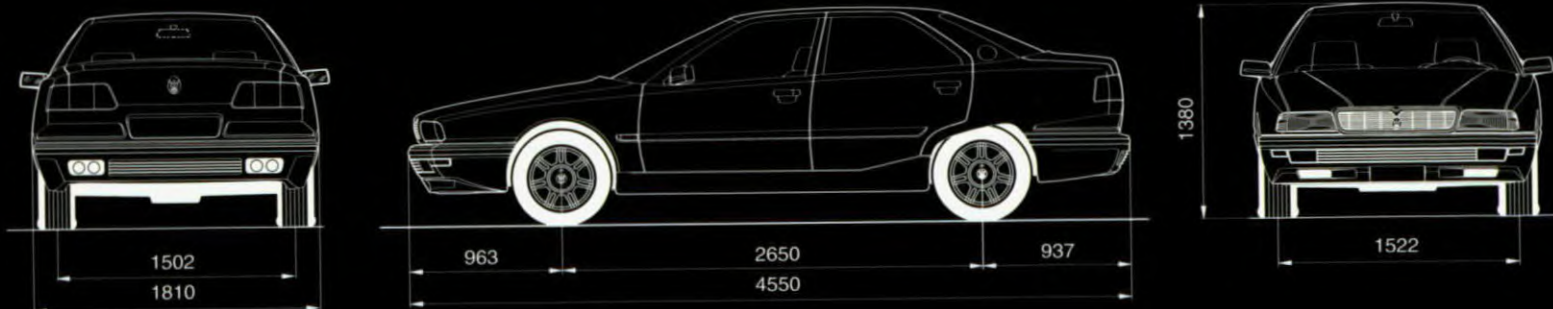
